A THRIVING CENTRE FOR HEADINGLEY

Following a meeting Councillor Tim Goodall organised between local residents and council officials, a problem-solving group has been set up.

This will involve local residents and bring in extra resources to make the Otley Run safer and calmer.

Tim said “Thanks to all the residents who have worked so hard to highlight this issue and make changes happen.”

Some participants say “it’s just fun”, but others disagree for many reasons:

- Shops and cafés lose money because nobody wants to go out during the Otley Run.
- Fights, physical assaults and intimidation.
- Sexual harassment.

- Families with children forced into the road because Otley Runners take up the whole pavement.
- Traffic accidents caused by drunk people walking into the road.
- Hospitalisation from severe alcohol poisoning.
- Huge queues at bars - 2000

people were counted in 3 hours.

- Children walking through vomit/broken glass on their way to school.

Tim said “My vision for Headingley and Hyde Park is to have more locally owned businesses that keep our strong sense of community – places like a DIY store, a toy shop, a dry cleaner.”



PROTECTING OUR WILDFLOWER MEADOW

Councillor Tim Goodall worked with Friends of Woodhouse Moor and ecologists from the University of Leeds to stop the destruction of the wildflower meadow on Woodhouse Moor.

This space safeguards biodiversity and is cherished by local residents, who objected to the council replacing it with trees.

Tim said “We need more trees, but there are other places they can be planted.

“I’m glad that the council have paused to reconsider and I’ll do all I can to save the meadow”.

EXPANSION AT LEEDS BRADFORD AIRPORT



Leeds Bradford Airport is trying to increase its night flights, disrupting sleep and increasing carbon emissions.

Nationally, Labour are pushing for airport expansion and selling 'sustainable' fuels as the answer, but flights can't run on these fuels yet and the climate crisis is happening now.

Tim said: "I'm proud that I was involved in creating the **Group for Action on Leeds Bradford Airport (GALBA)**, which is challenging the airport on night flights."
