PENNY HANDS NO. 7 TRANSDEV BUS PETITION TO DIRECTOR OF BUS SERVICES

Penny Stables and local residents presented a petition of over 1000 signatures to Tim Taylor, the Director of Transport Services at West Yorkshire Combined Authority (WYCA) at Leeds City Hall on 21st February. Thank you to Christine Petch and Matt Fisher who organised the petition.

Penny has been informed that the Transdev No. 7 bus is now under consideration for futher financial support. Penny will continue to work with Transdev and WYCA to improve this service. She is also trying to set up a new bus service between Wetherby and York via Boston Spa and Tadcaster.



PENNY CALLS FOR BUS SHELTER IN WETHERBY

Penny is working to get a bus shelter with a seat installed at the bus stop on Walton Road, Wetherby. Some older residents have told us that they are concerned about potential impact to their health when having to wait at a bus stop with no shelter in bad weather or that they have difficulty standing for longer periods. She is working with Wetherby Town Council to try to secure funding.

PLANNING UPDATES

Bramham House, Bramham – The developers are currently discussing a new planning application with the Planners, as a pre-application.

Battery Energy Storage System, Warren Lane, Bramham - Going to an appeal hearing on 20th May: ref. APP/N4720/W/24/3355821- BESS. As more information has been supplied by the applicant, the Council will not be challenging the appeal.

Land East of Smiddy Hill, Walton – application for a farmshop and café: 24/07396/FU. This application has been allowed on appeal. They have now submitted a change to the plan to significantly increase the size of the shop and café but must meet conditions including an agreed drainage plan.

East of Church Street, Boston Spa - : 23/02872/FU. McCarthy Stone's appeal against planning application refusal to build 49 retirement living apartments will be at a hearing 23 & 24 April. 10am in the Civic Hall, Leeds. It is open to the public.
